- **SCIOTO COUNTY WELCOME CENTER** Provides information about Scioto County, eateries, tourist locations, businesses & more.
- PORTSMOUTH FLOOD WALL MURALS 2,000 Years of History depicted along 2,000 feet of art illustrating the history of the area.
- **COURT ST. LANDING** A river front access perfect to enjoy views of the Ohio River, fish, boat, or have a picnic.
- **YORK PARK** Picnic area, stunning view & recreation on the Ohio River.

& overlooking the Ohio River & Kentucky.

- **SHAWNEE STATE UNIVERSITY** Established in 1986, SSU lies on the north bank of the Ohio River.

 A downtown green space perfect for concerts, the farmers market, lunch, or gathering.
- **SOUTHERN OHIO MUSEUM** Enriching the regional community with its galleries & programs.
- PORTSMOUTH PUBLIC LIBRARY A Carnegie Library established in 1879, it's rich in history & a resource for genealogy research.
- TRACY PARK Perfect location for a picnic, playground, or concert. War memorials & outdoor stage.
- SHAWNEE STATE PARK Nestled in the 63,000-acre Shawnee State Forest west of Portsmouth. Endless recreation possibilities.






A DISCOVER HISTORY ACTIVITY ROUTES
