- 1 HISTORIC BONEYFIDDLE DISTRICT**
From artwork by local artisans to antiques to eateries—this is a fun area to frequent.
- 2 PORTSMOUTH RACEWAY PARK**
A 3/8 mile clay track for late models, modified, street stocks, & bombers.
- 3 ALEXANDRIA POINT PARK**
Picnic area, stunning views and sunsets overlooking the Ohio & Scioto rivers.
- 4 PORTSMOUTH MOTORCYCLE CLUB**
In existence since 1893, making it one of the oldest clubs in the nation.
- 5 PORTSMOUTH BREWERY CO.**
Ohio's oldest operating brewery. American owned & brewed. Ohio proud.
- 6 SCIOTO COUNTY WELCOME CENTER**
Provides information about Scioto County, eateries, tourist locations, businesses & more.
- 7 PORTSMOUTH FLOOD WALL MURALS**
2,000 Years of History depicted along 2,000 feet of art illustrating the history of the area.
- 8 COURT ST. LANDING**
A river front access perfect to enjoy views of the Ohio River, fish, boat, or have a picnic.
- 9 YORK PARK**
Picnic area, stunning view & recreation on the Ohio River.

- 10 RIVERFRONT LEVEE WALK**
A makeshift walking trail sitting atop the levee & overlooking the Ohio River & Kentucky.
- 11 SHAWNEE STATE UNIVERSITY**
Established in 1986, SSU lies on the north bank of the Ohio River.
- 12 ROY ROGER'S ESPLANADE**
A downtown green space perfect for concerts, the farmers market, lunch, or gathering.
- 13 SOUTHERN OHIO MUSEUM**
Enriching the regional community with its galleries & programs.
- 14 PORTSMOUTH PUBLIC LIBRARY**
A Carnegie Library established in 1879, it's rich in history & a resource for genealogy research.
- 15 TRACY PARK**
Perfect location for a picnic, playground, or concert. War memorials & outdoor stage.
- 16 SHAWNEE STATE PARK**
Nestled in the 63,000-acre Shawnee State Forest west of Portsmouth. Endless recreation possibilities.

- 17 MOUND PARK**
Ancient Native American Horseshoe Mound, picnic area, baseball, tennis, basketball, & playground.
- 18 GREENLAWN CEMETERY**
A historic cemetery with interesting carvings & statues.
- 19 WAYNE NATIONAL FOREST**
The only National Forest in Ohio lies east of Portsmouth. Over 300 miles of hiking, horse & ATV trails.
- 20 SPARTAN MUNICIPAL STADIUM**
Home of National Football Leagues Portsmouth Spartans from 1930-1933.
- 21 BRANCH RICKEY PARK**
Named for local native, Branch Rickey, renowned coach, innovator & author who signed Jackie Robinson.

GEOGRAPHY

PORTSMOUTH, OHIO lies at the confluence of the Ohio & Scioto Rivers. Together, the rivers carve a valley & the perfect nesting spot for the community. Portsmouth is a midway point between four major cities: Charleston, Cincinnati, Lexington & Columbus, all of which are approximately ninety miles away.

Portsmouth is tucked between two large forests—Shawnee State park & Wayne National Forest. Much of the terrain is filled with rolling hills, forest wildflowers, and colorful foliage.
